**Who Can Participate in the camp** – College Students of 18 + ages who want to do something different in their life from any field like Medicine, Engineering, Law, Management, Social Work, Education or from any of the streams ( Arts, Commerce, Science etc); Interested non-student youths, teachers/ professors & volunteers/workers. (There is NO upper age limit)

**How to reach the Anandwan - the Venue of Camp :** Anandwan is 100 kms from both Wardha & Nagpur. So Participants coming from Pune/Mumbai can get down at Wardha/Nagpur. Then take bus for Warora (on Nagpur – Chandrapur Highway). Get down at Anandwan Square, before entering in Warora ST stand. Then take auto or walk for about one km to reach at the venue.

## Important Instructions for All

- Traveling expense will have to be managed individually. Registration Fees : Rs 400 for students/ Rs. 600 for others. (It includes food, residence & complimentary reading materials) We may offer some scholarships to few genuine & needy participants towards the reg. fees.
- Voluntary donations apart from Reg. fees, are welcome to make the activity self reliant.
- You can register online at our website [www.prayas-sevankur.org](http://www.prayas-sevankur.org) by filling up the online reg. form. Those who don't have internet facilities can contact on phone for registration. We will go through your reg. form & then if needed take telephonic interview before confirmation.
- Any college/institute can send 10 students & teachers for the camp. More no. will be allowed in selective cases on prior permission.
- Reach at the venue on 22<sup>nd</sup> Feb., Friday before 10 am. You can leave by 4 pm on Sunday, 24<sup>th</sup> Feb.
- Free Food-Accommodation from 22<sup>nd</sup> Feb. morning till the end of camp.
- What to carry with You : Notebook/pen/torch/enough money to purchase Life changing books, which will be available in discounted prices.
- You can bring Charts, Photos, Posters to be exhibited to present your activities & programs.
